EUTHANASIA. Mental Capacity Bill. MPs are being swamped by letters from the euthanasia lobby. We are asked by Pro-Life Parliamentarians, who have had some success with amendments, to write ourselves to our MP asking him to press the Government to make it clear that it will remain an offence under the Bill to deny medical treatment or food and fluids delivered by artificial means with the purpose of causing a patient's death; also that the Bill does not enshrine the Lords' 'Bland' judgement in statute.
