The theme last Sunday was evangelisation. The web seems to be increasingly significant. We are supplied with great detail about visits to our own web site. During the three weeks Sept 1st – 21st we had 5608 'hits'. Breaking these down by country there were 4177 from the USA, 527 from Sweden, 341 from within GB, 254 from the European Union, and 95 from Australia – with smaller numbers from all parts of the world. Not all made more than a brief visit but approximately 800 from the USA explored an average of 5 pages, with 100 from Sweden.

Sacred Heart School are this year to sell Christmas Puddings to raise money towards their building fund. These puddings are made by the Ultimate Plum Pudding Company, based in Cumbria, who only make them for charitable organisations and prestigious companies such as Lakeland Limited and Harvey Nichols.
